STREET MARKETS OF THE SMALL IRON OBJECTS

05.06.07 September 2025

The Autonomous Association for the European Biennial of Blacksmith Art - from now on called "The Association" – organizes the Street Markets that will take place on 05-06-07 September 2025 in Via E. De Amicis, Stia (Arezzo) during the 2025 Biennial of Blacksmithing Art.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE:

- hobbyists and non-professional operators who do not own any commercial business, but sell goods to consumers sporadically and occasionally
- trade operators

DURATION AND TIMETABLES OF THE STREET MARKETS:

The Street Markets will start on Friday 5th September 2025 at 10:00 a.m. and will end on Sunday 7th September 2025 at 7.00 p.m.; there will be about 10 workstations for the entire period.

The Market will be open to the public every day from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 p.m., except for 7th September when it will close at 7:00 p.m. Admission to the public is free. All exhibitors will be required to strictly comply with opening and closing times.

HOW TO REGISTER:

All participants must submit their registration form and a suitable photographic documentation of the objects offered for sale.

By submitting the application for participation, the applicant declares that they have read and unconditionally accept these general provisions.

All participants must submit the registration form along with appropriate photographic documentation of the items proposed for sale.

ADMISSION:

The Association will communicate by email the acceptance of the application form to the subjects who have been selected, by Monday 4th August 2025.

ALLOWED PRODUCTS:

At the Street Markets the display of the following products, made via metal or iron processing, is allowed:

- wrought iron jewelry (key rings, bracelets, rings, necklaces etc.)
- keys, locks, horseshoes
- antiques and modern antiques in iron
- knives
- small home decor items (small knick-knacks, hanging hooks, wine bottle holders etc.)

WAIVER AND CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS:

Anyone who decides, after receiving the participation confirmation notice, not to take part in the event must promptly send their cancellation notice by email before 7th August 2025.

Failure to pay the registration fee implies the renunciation to one's participation in the event; therefore only a flat rate of administrative expenses will be invoiced corresponding to €50.00.

The renunciation for serious and proven reasons (mourning, illness, etc.) communicated by registered letter and relative medical certificate will give the right to a reimbursement. Verbal or telephone communications are not accepted.

REGISTRATION FEE PAYMENT:

Payment must be made no later than Monday 11th August 2025.

Write in the **description "Street Markets 2025" followed by the name and surname of the participant**; send the receipt of the bank transfer to the Secretariat of the Biennale by email (ferrostitia@gmail.com) no later than the aforementioned date.

The reimbursement of the fee paid will be made only if the event is cancelled by the organization. In the event that the enrollee renounces or abandons the station assigned to him/her, the organization will not be required to reimburse the amount paid.

COSTS:

The available stations will be of 2 types:

- SINGLE station €60,00 for three days
- DOUBLE station €120,00 for three days

SELECTION:

The Evaluation Commission will examine the requests received by the deadline of 4th August 2025 and which fall into the categories mentioned above.

The choice of exhibitors and their products is based on selection criteria aimed at protecting the quality of the event and its success, considering the following criteria:

- the sale of goods that are distinguished by quality and by typicality and/or originality
- the differentiation of the offer between the goods present

DETAILS REGARDING THE EVENT:

Participants will arrange themselves according to the instructions given to them by the organizers upon arrival.

By "station" we mean a table with an approximate size of 220x70cm, with an umbrella with a lateral arm; in the case of a double workstation, we mean 2 tables side by side.

Table covers will also be provided for a homogeneous organization of the exhibition.

The organization will provide electricity for the sole purpose of illuminating the station: the use of any other type of high consumption/absorption lighting **IS PROHIBITED.**

Waxed tarps and anything else for the planting of objects during the hours when the Market is closed are not included.

The Association will not be responsible for the surveillance during the day and night, or in case of the owner's temporary absence.

LOADING AND UNLOADING:

Exhibitors will be given the opportunity to set up their own stand on Friday 5th September 2025 from 08:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Disassembly operations must take place on Sunday 7th September 2025 from 7:00 p.m. onwards.

During the day, no vehicles can park in the Street Markets area. Outside the indicated times it will NOT be possible to access the exhibition facilities using road vehicles.

PROHIBITIONS:

It is **forbidden** for the exhibitors to:

- Occupy spaces that are different or larger than those assigned
- Transfer all or part of the assigned spaces, which must be used exclusively by the requesting exhibitors, without the prior consent of the Steering Committee
- Use for the setting up staple guns, nails, adhesives, glues or other materials that could damage the exhibition structures
- Leave the station during the event or close early
- Intervene on the electrical system
- Sell and/or exhibit products not indicated in the application form
- Apply advertising panels or banners of any type or size.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in the exclusion from this event and from subsequent events organized by the Autonomous Association for the Biennial of Blacksmithing Art.

LIABILITY EXCLUSION:

The organizer declines all responsibility for damages to property or people resulting from atmospheric agents (snow, rain, wind) or from the exhibitor's neglect.

Furthermore, exhibitors are responsible for any damage caused to third parties (things or people) in relation to the activity they carry out in the areas entrusted to them.

Each exhibitor is obliged to leave the stand and the surrounding areas reserved for him/her clean and free of waste at the end of the event.
