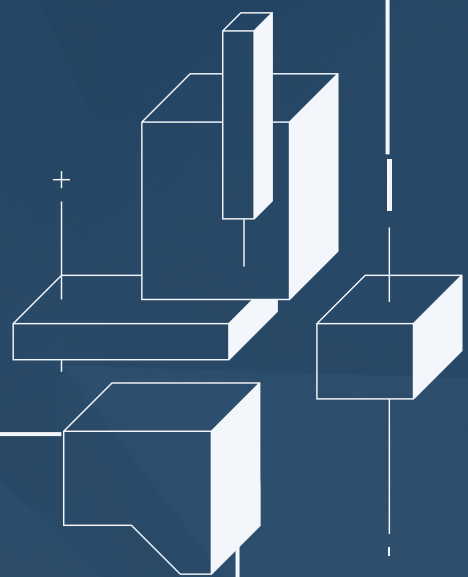
STIA SUMMER CAMP 2025
